Portraits probably showing three of the five sons of Rev Charles James Barnard (1797-1868), Rector of Bigby, Lincs. Only George Percy can be identified with certainty, as he served in the 34th Regiment of Foot (note cap badge); the others are probably two of his brothers. All three portraits were found in the clearance of the house of Ian Morin (1935-2023), a great grandson of the Charles James Barnard's daughter Adelaide Sophia (1834-1906) and were sold at auction by Walter Lloyd Jones of Barmouth on 27 Mar 2024 (lots 302, 303 and 304 respectively).
