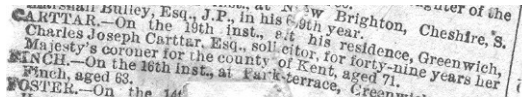


## Death Notice for Charles Joseph CARTTAR

*This notice appeared in an unidentified newspaper, and is pasted to a visiting card of Arthur Edward CLABBURN. The mother of Clabburn's wife (Rosey DE PEARSALL), Anna-Maria (nee HAMILTON-FFINNEY) married Charles Joseph CARTTAR's elder son, Charles Graham CARTTAR, following the death of her first husband (and Rosey's father), Robert Lucas DE PEARSALL the younger. It appears that Rosey remained close to the Carttar family.*

*No date is given, but Charles Joseph CARTTAR's dates were 9 Mar 1809 – 19 March 1880. He was elected Coroner for Kent 3 May 1832 in succession to his father, Joseph CARTTAR, so actually served in that role for a little under 48 years.*
